Dear Parents and Children:

We continue to put the well being and safety of your child(ren) at the top of our lists here at First Assembly of God on Wednesday evenings as we pursue the teaching of God's Word to be the most important aspect of ALL our Wednesday night activities.

*Children (fifth grade and younger) who arrive before 7:00 p.m. are to be in the gym or in the classrooms (teachers / helpers will be in their classrooms by 6:45 p.m.). **NO students before 6:45 p.m. on the premises unless they are with parents or assigned adults.** During the winter months, cancellation of services for weather conditions will be given on KBOE at 104.9 FM or 740 AM or KCWN at 99.9 FM radio stations.*

7:00 p.m. Bell for students to be in the classrooms with their leaders.

8:05 p.m. Bell for bus drivers/helpers to be in their bus/van.

8:10 p.m. Bell for bus/van children to be escorted by leader/helper to their assigned bus/van.

8:20 p.m. Bell for departure of bus/van, and other students will be dismissed from classrooms to go to the gym.

8:30 p.m. Students not yet picked up by parents will be taken to parents in sanctuary and all other children **MUST BE** picked up.

At 8:30 p.m., your child(ren) is your responsibility and we ask that you assume that responsibility. For liability purposes, children under the fifth grade will not be allowed outside until parents arrive to take the child(ren) home.

We have implemented and found that the following three-strike program on Wednesday evenings works and have found that these guidelines are of great benefit to maintain order, time and energies.

- **STRIKE ONE** - If after a student has been warned about his disruptive behavior, (on transportation, classroom, gym or premises) he/she continues to resist the teacher's authority, he/she will be sent to the office for the rest of the class period. A letter will be sent to the parent stating such action/behavior.
- **STRIKE TWO** – If in the following weeks the student continues to be disruptive, he/she will be immediately taken to the parent or if necessary to their home and will not be allowed to attend Wednesday night Club for the next two weeks or participate in any other church affiliated activities.
- **STRIKE THREE** - If a child's disruptive behavior persists, even after the two week suspension, he/she will not be allowed to return unless the parent requests a meeting with the church Business Administrator.

Again, our purpose for all of our children's activities is to help you as a parent instill in your child (ren) a love for God and His Word. Godly character, obedience and respect are just a few of the many lessons our leaders are teaching. Thank you for your cooperation and example. It is so important that you know where and what your children are doing.
